

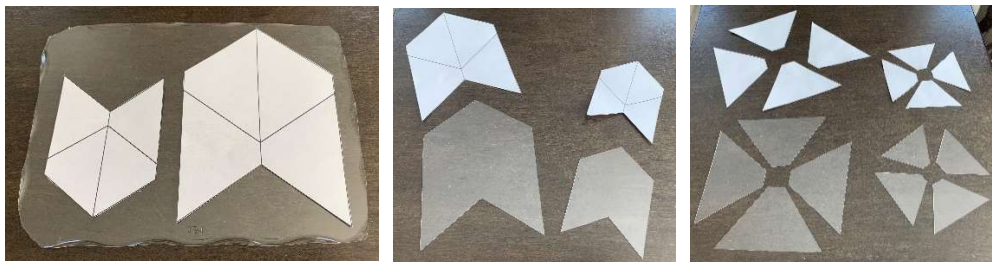
WUQWATR Kids Club DIY Hologram

What you need:

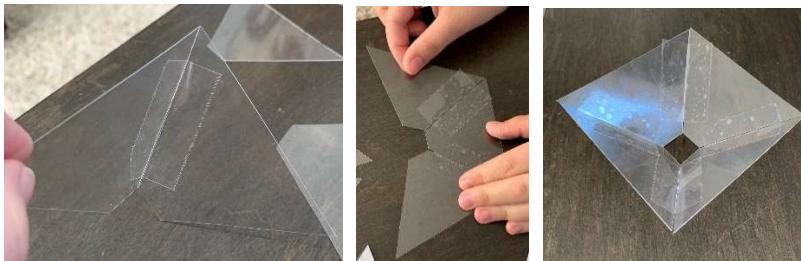
A Sturdy piece of flat, clear plastic; scissors, clear tape, and a tablet or smart phone

Start with your plastic. If you're using a container (fun way to repurpose your plastics!), cut off any rounded or wavy edges and remove any stickers so you're left with a clear flat sheet of plastic, ask a parent for help if this is too tricky! Print off the template from Silly Avacado (<http://sillyavacado.com/pdfs/SillyAVAcado-Pyramid-Hologram-Templates.pdf>)

Cut out the template pieces in the size you want to make (tablet or smart phone) and lay them on top of your plastic. Cut along the black lines so you're left with four identical pieces of plastic.



Next, you're going to tape the pieces together. Use your clear tape and tape the longest sides of each shape together like this:

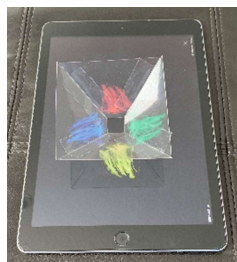


Now it's time to bring your hologram to life! *Please ask your parent or guardian before going online.*

Open a DIY hologram video on YouTube, we used this beautiful waterfall from:

Place your pyramid, with the small opening at the bottom, onto your tablet or smart phone in the centre of the image. This will work best in a dark room. Press play and look through the sides of your pyramid to make the hologram appear in 3D!
